



## PRESENTATION OUTLINE FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

1. Share with the students that they will be exploring career opportunities today through the TCIDS website designed specifically for them. TCIDS is the Tennessee Career Information Delivery System.
2. As the students to go to <http://tcids.tbr.edu/>.
3. As the students to click on “**TN Career of the Week**” and complete the following activities:
  - (1) View the video of individual in the career of the week
  - (2) View the video of an student studying that career
  - (3) Read the “**Real Facts**” of that career. Remind students that in order to answer the questions for the game, they must have read the “**Real Facts**” first
  - (4) Play the “**Millionaire Game**”
4. Direct the students to the “**Interest Survey**” at the top of the homepage and provide the following instructions:
  - (1) Follow the directions at the top of the page
  - (2) Read each question carefully and answer honestly
  - (3) Answer every question
  - (4) Click on “**Do It!**” to submit their responses
5. Ask the students to list the two careers they are most interested in from their personalized list.
6. As the students to list the one career that most interests them and instruct them to click on that career.
7. As the students to fill in the information about their career on their handout under question number 6:
  - (1) Give a brief job description
  - (2) List two duties of that career
  - (3) List the educational requirements

- (4) What is the job outlook for this occupation?
- (5) What is the salary range for this occupation?
- 8. Ask the students to click on “**Institutional Questionnaire**” and complete the survey. When they are finished, ask them to click “**Do It!**” to submit their responses.
- 9. Ask the students to list two institutions from their list of options that are of interest to them on their handout
- 10. Ask the students to select one institution and find the following information:\
  - (1) Name of the institution
  - (2) Location of the institution
  - (3) Annual room and board rates
  - (4) Major that relates to your chosen occupation
- 11. Ask the students to click on “**More Information**” at the top of the home page and go to “**Financial Aid.**” Ask the students to find one source of financial aid that can share with their parents.
- 12. Ask the students if they have further questions.
